ELECTION TIME!!!!

Election of the District 3 Director will be held at the District 3 Conference on April 27, 2019. As set forth in our governing documents, district directors shall be registered or professional registered members who have their principal residence in the district at the time of election and who are entitled to vote at the district conference at which they are elected. Those members entitled to vote must be a member of NAP who is registered as in attendance, has paid the appropriate registration fees and meets either of the following requirements:

a) primary member of an association in the district; or

b) member whose principal residence is in an unchartered state or province in the district and who is not a primary member of any association.

The elected District Director will take office at the close of the NAP convention and serve until the close of the next convention or until his/her successor assumes office.

The district director is tasked with promoting NAP programs and educational opportunities through the associations, provinces and to the general public. The district director also is a member of the national Membership Extension and Retention Committee (MERC). Please refer to the NAP Bylaws for a complete listing of duties.
